Organizational History of the Covenant Presbyterian Church: There is very little information about Covenant Presbyterian, but it was located in Clarkston.

Description: The Covenant Presbyterian Church collection includes correspondence, a flyer for family night, articles of constitution, and documents establishing the church in the old Scottdale Elementary School on the corner of East Ponce de Leon and Laredo Drive in Scottdale. Also included are church bulletins handed out during services.
